## **EXPECTED RESULTS**

- Strengthened health systems to improve the health of men and women in target areas of Central Asia, especially women of reproductive age, newborns and children under five
- Strengthened teacher education and support systems to improve and sustain learning outcomes for boys and girls in pre-primary and primary school levels in target areas in East Africa
- Improved capacity of selected civil society organizations who conduct human development programming in Africa and Asia, particularly in the areas of gender equality, innovation or sustainable climate change adaptation
- Increased engagement of targeted Canadians and Canadian and indigenous institutions in activities that support human development
