- ❖ Strengthened teacher education and support systems to improve and sustain learning outcomes for boys and girls in pre-primary and primary school levels in target areas in East Africa
- ❖ Improved capacity of selected civil society organizations who conduct human development programming in Africa and Asia, particularly in the areas of gender equality, innovation or sustainable climate change adaptation
- ❖ Increased engagement of targeted Canadians and Canadian and indigenous institutions in activities that support human development
