Instructions:

Talk about what a map is with your friend how it is used & what information it has. If you have one, look at it & discuss it.

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Draw a map of your neighbourhood. Include familiar landmarks on it such as shops, playgrounds, a friend's or neighbour's house, school, etc.

Check the map's accuracy. Take a walk around the neighbourhood to check that the information on the map is accurate & make corrections if needed.





Talking Ball





The one who starts with the ball should act out an action word (a verb) e.g., bring hands together, open hands, repeat quickly.

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The other people should try to guess the action. Keep guessing until someone gets it right. Once correct, the one with the ball throws it to the second person.

Continue the game until everyone takes a turn or until each player has had five turns. How many different verbs did each player guess correctly?
